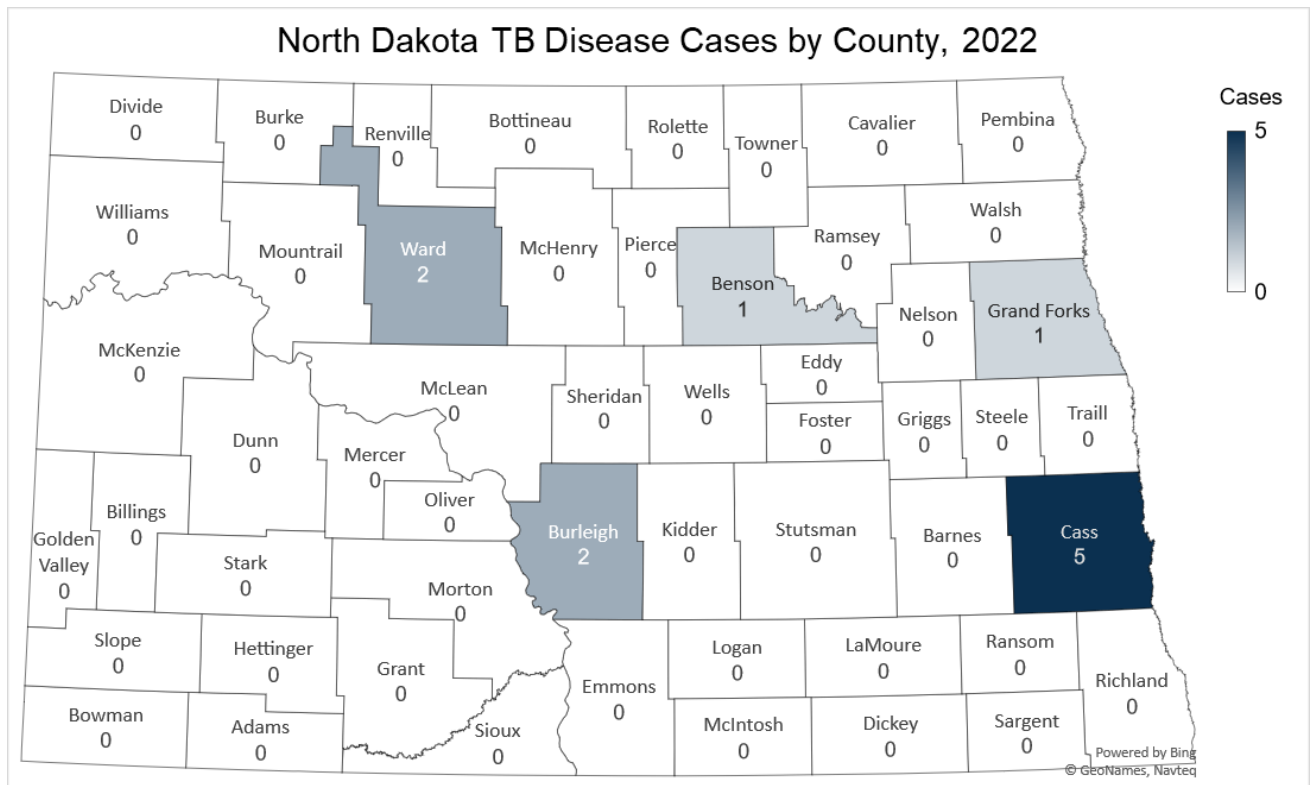


2022 TB Risk Assessment Surveillance Data

In 2022, 11 cases of active tuberculosis were reported to the North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services.

Cases of TB disease were reported in the following counties: Cass (5), Burleigh (2), Ward (2), Benson (1), and Grand Forks (1).



Statewide, the incidence rate of TB disease in 2022 was 1.41 cases per 100,000 people.

The most recent national surveillance data available are from 2021. The incidence rate of TB disease in the United States in 2021 was 2.4 cases per 100,000 people.¹
